One in 10 households struggles to put food on their table.**

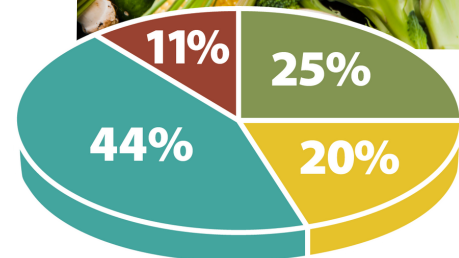
69% of households served fall into the extremely low income bracket with an additional 18% of households falling into the low income bracket.

The Kids' Mart is a special section of the walk-in pantry now open once a week to our clients. Children are given options to pick their own food while learning the benefits of healthy eating. Choices include dairy, fruits, grains, protein and vegetables, plus a book to take home.

\$110,500 Cost of FFT program for one school year
